CHANGES TO PRIOR AUTHORIZATION REQUIREMENTS FOR RADIOLOGY SERVICES

UPDATED FEBRUARY 21, 2019

Beginning March 1, 2019 outpatient radiology services will be redirected to be performed by freestanding radiology network providers. This change impacts all members of University of Maryland Health Partners (Maryland Medicaid) and University of Maryland Health Advantage (Medicare D-SNP).

The following preventive and screening radiology services **do not** need an authorization, but should be directed to freestanding radiology network providers: mammograms, AAA ultrasound, OB ultrasound, and low dose lung CT.

Radiology services performed by **freestanding radiology** network providers **do not** require prior authorization. This includes CT, CTA, Digital Xray, MRI, MRA, PET, Nuclear Stress Test, and Ultrasound.

<u>Important:</u> When submitting a request for radiology service(s) to be performed at an outpatient hospital setting, please remember to include the reason the service(s) cannot be performed by a freestanding radiology network provider. All requests will be reviewed administratively for place of service. If the service can be performed by a freestanding radiology network provider, the request will be redirected.
